### WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Skin and Wound Care

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.

**Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 55 (1) 3.**

Skin and wound care

s. 55 (1) The skin and wound care program must, at a minimum, provide for the following:

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3. Strategies to transfer and position residents to reduce and prevent skin breakdown and reduce and relieve pressure, including the use of equipment, supplies, devices and positioning aids.

In accordance with O. Reg. 246/22 s. 11(1)(b), the licensee is required to ensure any plan, policy, protocol, program, procedure, strategy, initiative or system, for the skin and wound care program, was complied with.

An inspector observed a resident who was found without their pressure relieving device which was not in place as per their care plan.
