Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 134. Residents' drug regimes

Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,

(a) when a resident is taking any drug or combination of drugs, including psychotropic drugs, there is monitoring and documentation of the resident's response and the effectiveness of the drugs appropriate to the risk level of the drugs;

(b) appropriate actions are taken in response to any medication incident involving a resident and any adverse drug reaction to a drug or combination of drugs, including psychotropic drugs; and

(c) there is, at least quarterly, a documented reassessment of each resident's drug regime. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 134.

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The home failed to monitor and document one resident's response to the effectiveness of drugs appropriate to the risk level of the drugs. Review of one resident health record revealed a resident was prescribed a narcotic analgesic every 6 hours as needed. The resident's response to administration of the medication was not documented on seven occasions in January, 2013. Interview with one Registered Practical Nurse confirmed the resident's response was not documented. [s. 134. (a)]
