During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator, Director of Care, two Registered Practical Nurses and one Personal Service Worker.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed two resident health records, one critical incident report, client services response form, resident internal incident report and the home's Fall Intervention policy.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

- s. 6. (10) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time when,
- (a) a goal in the plan is met; 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (10).
- (b) the resident's care needs change or care set out in the plan is no longer necessary; or 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (10).
- (c) care set out in the plan has not been effective. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (10).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. The home did not ensure the residents were reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time when the resident's care needs change or care set out in the plan of care is no longer necessary.

Review of the health record for two residents and interview with four staff confirm the written plan of care for each resident was not revised to include management of a change in their care needs.[s. 6. (10) (b)]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance related to ensuring the plan of care is revised when the resident's care needs change,, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 49. Falls prevention and management

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 49. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that when a resident has fallen, the resident is assessed and that where the condition or circumstances of the resident require, a post-fall assessment is conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for falls. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 49 (2).



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Findings/Faits saillants:

1. When a resident has fallen, the home did not ensure a post-fall assessment has been conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for falls.

Review of one resident health record and interview with two staff, confirmed an assessment using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument was not completed. [s. 49. (2)]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance related to ensuring a post-fall assessment has been conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for falls,, to be implemented voluntarily.
