Non-compliance with: 0. Reg. 246/22, s. 40

Transferring and positioning techniques

s. 40. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that staff use safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting residents.

The licensee failed to ensure that staff used safe transferring techniques when transferring a resident.

Rationale and Summary:

Two staff used unsafe transferring techniques when transferring a resident, causing the resident to sustain injuries.

Both staff confirmed that unsafe transferring techniques were used.

Failure to ensure that staff used safe transferring techniques resulted in an injury for a resident.
