Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection

The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): February 10, 11, 12, 2021.

This inspection was conducted in reference to intake logs #026102-20 and #000157-21, a complaint and CIS #2683-000011-20 related to an injury sustained by resident #001.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator, the Director of Care, Registered Nurses, Registered Practical Nurses, Personal Support Workers, family and resident.

During this inspection the Inspector observed residents' environments, the provision of care and services to residents, reviewed relevant resident health care records, and policies and procedures related to Pain Management.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 52. Pain management

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 52. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that when a resident's pain is not relieved by initial interventions, the resident is assessed using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument specifically designed for this purpose. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 52 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee failed to ensure that when a resident's pain was not relieved by initial interventions, the resident was assessed using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument specifically designed for this purpose.

During a 15 day period, a resident's progress notes documented the resident's expression of pain, which was not a normal response for the resident. The Director of Care (DOC) indicated that a pain assessment form had not been completed on the resident during that time frame, which increased the resident's risk for on-going pain.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that when a resident's pain is not relieved by initial interventions, the resident is assessed using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument specifically designed for this purpose, to be implemented voluntarily.
