Rationale and Summary

During this inspection, the inspector observed the lunch service on the main floor in the Cozy Corner and Rural Retreats dining rooms. No resident was provided assistance for performing hand hygiene by the staff.

A staff member stated all residents are to be offered hand hygiene prior to and after meals. A poster was observed on both doors to the dining room stating "Hand hygiene is to be performed before and after meals."



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The Director of Care (DOC) and Assistant Director of Care (ADOC) confirmed that all staff are expected to assist residents with hand hygiene prior to their meals and snacks.

By not performing hand hygiene there is an increased risk of disease transmission among residents and staff.
