The licensee has failed to ensure that when in a Covid-19 outbreak, the Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) audit was completed weekly as required by the



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Minister's Directive: COVID-19 response measures for long-term care homes Effective: August 30, 2022.

Rationale and Summary

An outbreak of Covid-19 was declared by Public Health and was declared over by Public Health weeks later.

Record review of the home's Public Health Ontario IPAC Audits during the outbreak period identified that an audit was not completed for thirteen consecutive days.

There was low risk and impact to resident's when the home did not complete the Public Health Ontario IPAC Audit weekly during an outbreak of Covid-19.
