WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Transferring and Positioning techniques

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 40

Transferring and positioning techniques

s. 40. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that staff use safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting residents.

The licensee failed to ensure that staff used safe transferring techniques for a resident.



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A Critical Incident Report (CIR) was submitted by the home to indicate a concern that two Personal Support Workers did not consistently assist an identified resident safely.

The plan of care for the resident, and interviews with nursing staff all indicated that the resident required a higher level of assistance.

The PSW's confirmed that they had offered the resident a lower level of assistance despite being aware of the resident needs.
