Infection prevention and control program s. 102 (2) The licensee shall implement,

(b) any standard or protocol issued by the Director with respect to infection prevention and control. O. Reg. 246/22, s. 102 (2).

The licensee has failed to ensure that the *Infection Prevention and Control Standard* for Long-Term Care Homes (April, 2022; revised, 2023) (the IPAC Standard), issued by the Director with respect to infection prevention and control was implemented.

Specifically, a staff member did not comply with additional requirement 9.1 (f) of the *IPAC Standard* when they did not use the required personal protective equipment as they repositioned a resident who required additional precautions.
