WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 6. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident that sets out,
- (a) the planned care for the resident;
- (b) the goals the care is intended to achieve; and
- (c) clear directions to staff and others who provide direct care to the resident. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. The most recent plan of care that is accessed by the Personal Support Worker staff for a resident is dated as printed on November 13, 2011.

The interventions that have been added to the plan of care (as recently as December 8, 2011) are not accessible for the Personal Support Workers.

Staff on the unit and the Director of Care confirmed that the most recent plan of care that is accessed by nursing staff is on the resident's chart.
