The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator, Director of Care, Registered Nurse, Registered Practical Nurse, Personal Support Workers, Dietary Aide, Residents and Family Members.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed the clinical records of one resident, observed staff-resident interactions and observed dining service related to L-001404-12.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 73. Dining and snack service Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 73. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home has a dining and snack service that includes, at a minimum, the following elements:
- 1. Communication of the seven-day and daily menus to residents.
- 2. Review, subject to compliance with subsection 71 (6), of meal and snack times by the Residents' Council.
- 3. Meal service in a congregate dining setting unless a resident's assessed needs indicate otherwise.
- 4. Monitoring of all residents during meals.
- 5. A process to ensure that food service workers and other staff assisting residents are aware of the residents' diets, special needs and preferences.
- 6. Food and fluids being served at a temperature that is both safe and palatable to the residents.
- 7. Sufficient time for every resident to eat at his or her own pace.
- 8. Course by course service of meals for each resident, unless otherwise indicated by the resident or by the resident's assessed needs.
- 9. Providing residents with any eating aids, assistive devices, personal assistance and encouragement required to safely eat and drink as comfortably and independently as possible.
- 10. Proper techniques to assist residents with eating, including safe positioning of residents who require assistance.
- 11. Appropriate furnishings and equipment in resident dining areas, including comfortable dining room chairs and dining room tables at an appropriate height to meet the needs of all residents and appropriate seating for staff who are assisting residents to eat. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 73 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:

- 1. During observation of a meal service, documentation regarding therapeutic diets and/or textures was not consulted by the dietary aide serving the meals.
- The personal support workers obtaining entrees from the dietary aide asked for meals by "regular" or "puree" and not by the resident name. Therapeutic diet forms were not consulted prior to serving the meals.
- 2. The posted menu in the dining room was not the correct menu for that date.
- 3. During meal service four residents were served their entrees, but did not receive assistance to eat for at least 15 minutes. One resident received her entree and waited over 20 minutes for assistance.



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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance with ensuring that dining service for all meals meet the legislative requirements related to menu posting; that a process is in place to ensure that food service workers and other staff assisting residents are aware of diets, special needs and preferences and that a process is in place to ensure that residents are provided with assistance as soon as a meal is served to them, to be implemented voluntarily.
