Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 40

Transferring and positioning techniques s. 40. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that staff use safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting residents.

The licensee has failed to ensure that a staff member used safe positioning devices and techniques when assisting a resident. The staff member failed to use a positioning device when re-positioning the resident.
