s. 6 (10) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time when,
(b) the resident's care needs change or care set out in the plan is no longer necessary; or

The licensee failed to ensure a resident's care plan was revised when their bedtime changed. A staff shared they had been assisting the resident to bed at the same time for at least one year. The resident had a preferred bed time noted in their care plan that differed from the time they were being assisted to bed, and had not been changed since their admission. A second staff confirmed staff would monitor the resident and potentially assist them to bed at a different time based on care needs.
