WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 33. Bathing Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 33. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that each resident of the home is bathed, at a minimum, twice a week by the method of his or her choice and more frequently as determined by the resident's hygiene requirements, unless contraindicated by a medical condition. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 33 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:

- 1. The licensee has failed to comply with section 33 (1) of the O.Reg 79/10 in that two baths per week were not given to an identified resident.
- 2. The resident's daily care flow sheet was reviewed and there was an entry indicating the resident refused his/her shower in September 2011.
- 3. There was no indication that the resident was re-scheduled for a shower.
- 3. Interviewed Registered staff, she states that when a resident refuses a shower, the resident is not necessarily rescheduled for a shower.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 131. Administration of drugs Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 131. (2) The licensee shall ensure that drugs are administered to residents in accordance with the directions for use specified by the prescriber. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 131 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants :

- 1. The licensee has failed to comply with section 131 (2) of the Act in that it failed to administer the medications as prescribed.
- 2. An identified resident was admitted in August, 2011.
- 3. The admission medication orders indicates that they were approved by the physician to be administered on day of admission.
- 4. The medication administration records, indicates that the medications were not available and not administered for 2 days post admission.



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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that drugs are administered to residents as specified by the prescriber., to be implemented voluntarily.
