Residents' Bill of Rights



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- s. 3 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following rights of residents are fully respected and promoted:
- 19. Every resident has the right to,

iv. have their personal health information within the meaning of the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004 kept confidential in accordance with that Act, and to have access to their records of personal health information, including their plan of care, in accordance with that Act.

When the home was completing a critical incident report (CI) for the Ministry of Long-Term Care, they entered a resident's personal information, including the resident's personal health information into an online internet application. As a result, a residents' personal health information was not kept confidential in accordance with the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004.
