The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

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Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 57. Powers of Residents' Council Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 57. (2) If the Residents' Council has advised the licensee of concerns or recommendations under either paragraph 6 or 8 of subsection (1), the licensee shall, within 10 days of receiving the advice, respond to the Residents' Council in writing. 2007, c. 8, s. 57.(2).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. The home was notified of concerns related to the provision of care from residents at the July Resident's Council Meeting. The Director of Care responded on August 1, 2011 indicating that the concerns would be taken forward to the Registered Staff and Personal Support Worker Meetings. The Director of Care confirms that a meeting was held with Registered staff and Personal Support Workers, but information from this meeting was not shared with the Resident's Council, Discussion with the Director of Care confirms that no further response was sent to the Resident's Council. Resident's Council expressed concern that they would like the home to take action to address residents who demonstrate rude behaviour with their peers. No response was documented and returned to the Resident's Council.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 31. Nursing and personal support services Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 31. (3) The staffing plan must,
- (a) provide for a staffing mix that is consistent with residents' assessed care and safety needs and that meets the requirements set out in the Act and this Regulation;
- (b) set out the organization and scheduling of staff shifts;
- (c) promote continuity of care by minimizing the number of different staff members who provide nursing and personal support services to each resident;
- (d) include a back-up plan for nursing and personal care staffing that addresses situations when staff, including the staff who must provide the nursing coverage required under subsection 8 (3) of the Act, cannot come to
- (e) be evaluated and updated at least annually in accordance with evidence-based practices and, if there are none, in accordance with prevailing practices. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 31 (3).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. Discussion with the Administrator and Director of Care confirms that the staffing plan for the home does not include a back-up plan for nursing and personal care staffing that addresses situation when staff cannot come to work, and has not been evaluated and updated at least annually.



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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance ensuring that there is a written staffing plan for the nursing services and personal support services that includes a back up plan that is evaluated annually, to be implemented voluntarily.
