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INSPECTION RESULTS

Non-Compliance Remedied

Non-compliance was found during this inspection and was **remedied** by the licensee prior to the conclusion of the inspection. The inspector was satisfied that the non-compliance met the intent of section 154 (2) and requires no further action.

The licensee has failed to ensure that drugs were stored in a medication cart that was secure and locked.

Rationale and Summary

Two registered staff were observed sitting in the nursing station with their medication carts unattended and unlocked in the hallway across the nursing station. No residents were around the cart.

Staff stated that medication carts should always be kept locked when not in use and locked the medication carts immediately.
