Skin and wound care

s. 55 (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,

(b) a resident exhibiting altered skin integrity, including skin breakdown, pressure injuries, skin tears or wounds,

(i) receives a skin assessment by an authorized person described in subsection (2.1), using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for skin and wound assessment,

The licensee has failed to ensure that a resident received a skin assessment for a wound on a specified date in December 2024, by an authorized person described in subsection (2.1); using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument, identified by the home as the Think, Research, Collaboration (TRC) Wound Assessment within Point Click Care.
