Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection

The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Critical Incident inspection.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed the clinical notes of 1 resident, reviewed the homes policy and procedures related to education and Lift/Transfer-Resident Mobility, and observed a resident lift and transfer.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 76. Training

Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 76. (4) Every licensee shall ensure that the persons who have received training under subsection (2) receive retraining in the areas mentioned in that subsection at times or at intervals provided for in the regulations. 2007, c. 8, s. 76. (4).

Findings/Faits sayants :

1. On Aug 16, 2011 - 13:26 A review of the homes policies related to Education Programs Policy number 1.6.1 indicates that Education will be offered annually related to safe and correct use of lift and transfer equipment.

The home was unable to produce annual re-training records for safe and correct use of lift transfer equipment for employees involved in a recent incident.

LTCHA, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.76. (2)(4).

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure all staff receive re-training annually related to safe and correct use of equipment (mechanical lifts), to be implemented voluntarily.
