### Non-Compliance Remedied

**Non-compliance** was found during this inspection and was **remedied** by the licensee prior to the conclusion of the inspection. The inspector was satisfied that the non-compliance met the intent of section 154 (2) and requires no further action.

Plan of care

s. 6 (10) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time when, (b) the resident's care needs change or care set out in the plan is no longer necessary.

The licensee has failed to ensure that the plan of care related to transferring, toileting and mobility for a resident was updated when the resident's care needs changed after a fall resulting in a significant change. The plan of care, including logs, the care plan and kardex, were updated on December 18 and 19, 2024.
