WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 3. Residents' Bill of Rights



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 3. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following rights of residents are fully respected and promoted:

11. Every resident has the right to,

i. participate fully in the development, implementation, review and revision of his or her plan of care,

ii. give or refuse consent to any treatment, care or services for which his or her consent is required by law and to be informed of the consequences of giving or refusing consent,

iii. participate fully in making any decision concerning any aspect of his or her care, including any decision concerning his or her admission, discharge or transfer to or from a long-term care home or a secure unit and to obtain an independent opinion with regard to any of those matters, and

iv. have his or her personal health information within the meaning of the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004 kept confidential in accordance with that Act, and to have access to his or her records of personal health information, including his or her plan of care, in accordance with that Act. 2007, c. 8, s. 3 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The inspector observed residents' personal health information including residents' names, diets, textures, any special needs, details on feeding assistance, and health conditions posted on each dining room tables and on 3rd floor servery cart. This can be easily identified by anyone who enters to the dining area.

Food Service Manager confirmed that the home keeps residents' diet information on tables and cart for ease of staff to ensure that residents receive appropriate diet and texture.

Note: Home has corrected this procedure and removed residents personal health information from the dining room tables and ensured the inspectors that from now onwards home will be using those personal information kept in binders during meal services to ensure residents receive appropriate diet and texture. WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 15. Accommodation services



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 15. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,

(a) the home, furnishings and equipment are kept clean and sanitary; 2007, c. 8, s. 15 (2).

(b) each resident's linen and personal clothing is collected, sorted, cleaned and delivered; and 2007, c. 8, s. 15 (2).

(c) the home, furnishings and equipment are maintained in a safe condition and in a good state of repair. 2007, c. 8, s. 15 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. Licensee failed to ensure that the home's furnishings and equipment are maintained in a safe condition and in a good state of repair. Observation conducted on residents' dining room on third floor revealed that a large damaged area on the dry wall, in front of the television in need of repair.

Note: Home ensured that, the home will fixed the wall on 3rd floor dining area by next day. [s. 15. (2) (c)]
