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s. 272. The licensee has failed to ensure that recommendations issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health or a medical officer of health appointed under the Health Protection and Promotion Act were followed in the home.

In accordance with the Recommendations for Outbreak Prevention and Control in Institutions and Congregate Living Settings (February 2025), Section 3.1, Alcoholbased hand rubs (ABHR) must not be expired. During inspectors' observations on May 20, 2025, nine hand pump ABHRs located within the dining room, and one hand pump ABHR located within the entry of the home, were noted to have an expiry date of April, 2025.
