WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Administration of Drugs

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 140 (2)

Administration of drugs

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s. 140 (2) The licensee shall ensure that drugs are administered to residents in accordance with the directions for use specified by the prescriber. O. Reg. 246/22, s. 140 (2).

Review of a resident's clinical record showed that a medication was ordered on a specific date. A Physician's order was written two days later adding an additional medication. Review of the resident's electronic medication administration record (eMAR) showed that the original medication had been discontinued on the date the second medication was ordered by the physician.

During an interview with the Physician they acknowledged that the original medication was not to be discontinued.
