Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection



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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Critical Incident System inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): May 31- June 3, 2021 and June 7 and 8, 2021.

The following logs were completed in this Critical Incident (CI) System inspection:

Log #007627-21 (CI #2845-000007-21) and log #008366-21(CI #2845-000009-21) related to incident with injury, transfer to hospital, and change in condition.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Executive Director (ED), the Director of Care (DOC), the Infection Control Manager, the Nutritional Care Manager and Acting Environmental Services Manager (ESM), Registered Practical Nurses (RPN), and Personal Support Workers (PSW).

The inspector(s) also observed the provision of care and services to residents, staff to resident interactions, dining service, snack service, thermostats, and infection prevention and control practices; as well as reviewed resident health care records and Temperature and Humidex binders.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 21. Air temperature



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

- s. 21. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the temperature is measured and documented in writing, at a minimum in the following areas of the home:
- 1. At least two resident bedrooms in different parts of the home. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 21 (2).
- s. 21. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the temperature is measured and documented in writing, at a minimum in the following areas of the home:
- 2. One resident common area on every floor of the home, which may include a lounge, dining area or corridor. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 21 (2).
- s. 21. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the temperature is measured and documented in writing, at a minimum in the following areas of the home:
- 3. Every designated cooling area, if there are any in the home. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 21 (2).
- s. 21. (3) The temperature required to be measured under subsection (2) shall be documented at least once every morning, once every afternoon between 12 p.m. and 5 p.m. and once every evening or night. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 21 (3).

Findings/Faits saillants:



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1. The licensee has failed to ensure that the temperature of at least two resident bedrooms in different parts of the home, one resident common area on every floor, and every designated cooling area was measured and documented and that the measured temperature was documented at least once every morning, once every afternoon, and once every evening or night.

The inspector reviewed the Temperature and Humidex binder on two units. The binder is used to record the temperature and humidex of each of the two hallways on the unit, on the day, evening, and night shift. Review of the binders revealed that between June 1, 2021 and June 7, 2021, the temperatures were only recorded on one of the units on the night shift of June 4, 2021, and on the other unit was only recorded on the evening and night shift of June 4, 2021.

The Acting ESM explained that they will measure and document the temperature of both hallways, of all units, once a day in the morning. The Acting ESM indicated that the designated cooling areas of the home are the four dining rooms – one on each unit. They went on to explain that only two of the four dining room temperatures were regularly taken and documented, and this occurred once a day. Both the ED and The Acting ESM indicated that the temperature of at least two resident bedrooms in different parts of the home was not being measured or documented.

There is a risk to resident comfort and safety when the temperatures are not measured and documented in the specified areas of the home during the required time frames.

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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that the temperature is measured and documented in at least two resident bedrooms in different parts of the home, one resident common area on every floor, and every designated cooling area at least once every morning, once every afternoon, and once every evening or night, to be implemented voluntarily.
