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## **Non-Compliance Remedied**

**Non-compliance** was found during this inspection and was **remedied** by the licensee prior to the conclusion of the inspection. The inspector was satisfied that the non-compliance met the intent of section 154 (2) and requires no further action.

The licensee has failed to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) Standard for Long-Term Care Homes issued by the Director was complied with. In accordance with Additional Requirement 9.1 (e) under the IPAC Standard for Long-Term Care Homes (April 2022, revised September 2023), the licensee shall ensure that, at minimum, Additional Precautions included point-of-care signage indicating that enhanced IPAC control measures were in place, which did not occur for two residents, who required additional precautions. The signage was posted on the residents' door the same date.
