Non-compliance was found during this inspection and was **remedied** by the

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licensee prior to the conclusion of the inspection. The inspector was satisfied that the non-compliance met the intent of section 154 (2) and requires no further action.

CMOH and MOH

s. 272. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that all applicable directives, orders, guidance, advice or recommendations issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health or a medical officer of health appointed under the Health Protection and Promotion Act are followed in the home.

The licensee failed to ensure that all hand sanitizer products were not expired as per applicable directives issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health or a medical officer of health. As per a directive on page 26 of 'Recommendations for Outbreak Prevention and Control in Institutions and Congregate Living Settings' issued by the Ministry of Health, all hand sanitizer available in the home must have not been expired.

On July 3, 2025, Inspector observed two bottles of hand sanitizer and one wall unit hand sanitizer that were expired. These were replaced immediately when brought to the attention of the staff.
