WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 6. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident that sets out,
- (a) the planned care for the resident;
- (b) the goals the care is intended to achieve; and
- (c) clear directions to staff and others who provide direct care to the resident. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. The licensee of the long-term care home did not ensure that there was a written plan of care for each resident that sets out clear directions to staff and others who provide direct care to the resident.

Resident 004 was on a tube feed since 2012 and was to be positioned at forty-five degrees while the feed was running. Positioning needs were noted fifteen times since admission in the progress notes, however, this information was not included in the plan of care to provide clear direction to staff.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident that sets out clear direction for staff and others who provide direct care to the resident, to be implemented voluntarily.
