**Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 53 (1) 1.**

Required programs

s. 53 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following interdisciplinary programs are developed and implemented in the home:

1. A falls prevention and management program to reduce the incidence of falls and the risk of injury.

A resident's Head Injury Routine was not completed at the required time intervals six (6)

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out of seventeen (17) times.

In accordance with O. Reg 246/22, s. 11 (1) (b), the licensee is required to ensure that written policies developed for the falls prevention and management program were complied with. Specifically, the home's falls policy indicated the Registered Staff are required to assess the resident's pupils and levels of consciousness using the Head Injury Record (for 46 hours post head injury). During an interview with Director of Care they were unable to confirm that the required assessments were completed as per the scheduled timeframe.
