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INSPECTION RESULTS

WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Security of drug supply

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 139 1.

The licensee has failed to ensure that all areas where drugs were stored were kept locked at all times when not in use.

Rationale and Summary

A medication fridge in the long-term care home was found unlocked.

The Executive Director stated that the medication fridge should be locked. A Registered Practical Nurse (RPN) told the Inspector that they had been in the fridge about an hour before it had been found open, indicating that the fridge had been unlocked for at least one hour.

Failure to ensure the medication fridge remained locked when not in use put the security of the drug supply contained inside at risk.
