WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 5. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home is a safe and secure environment for its residents. 2007, c. 8, s. 5.

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. In the activity / physio/ resident lounge room construction tools, thread sealant cans x 4 with lids not secured, and lengths of piping propped against the table were found. The door to the room was found open. [LTCHA, 2007,S.O.2007, c.8, s.5]

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 56. Residents' Council Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 56. (2) Only residents of the long-term care home may be a member of the Residents' Council. 2007, c. 8, s. 56 (2)

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. At this time the Chair person of the Residents' Council is a volunteer and not a resident of the home. [LTCHA, 2007,S.O.2007, c.8, s.56.(2)]

WN #3: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 85. Satisfaction survey Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 85. (3) The licensee shall seek the advice of the Residents' Council and the Family Council, if any, in developing and carrying out the survey, and in acting on its results. 2007, c. 8, s. 85. (3).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. The Administrator confirmed the satisfaction survey is a corporate survey and is not aware of the advice being sought from Residents' Council in the development or carrying out the survey. [LTCHA, 2007,S.O.2007, c.8, s.85.(3)]



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WN #4: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 91. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that all hazardous substances at the home are labelled properly and are kept inaccessible to residents at all times. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 91.

Findings/Falts saillants:

1. Housekeeping cart was found to be unlocked and a bottle of chemical cleaner was found. Housekeeper was not within eye sight of cart.
