Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection

The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): July 31, August 1, 2, 2013

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with 3 Residents, 10 Personal Care Support Workers, 2 Registered Practical Nurses, 1 Registered Nurse, the Executive Director/Director of Care, the Assistant Director of Care, the Food Services Manager, and the Recreation Manager.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed 4 clinical records, and observed meal service and snack service.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 73. Dining and snack service



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 73. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home has a dining and snack service that includes, at a minimum, the following elements:

10. Proper techniques to assist residents with eating, including safe positioning of residents who require assistance. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 73 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. It was noted that 2 residents were being fed by a Personal Support Worker who was sitting much higher than the residents, not eye to eye at a safe feeding height. The Food services Manager confirmed this situation. The situation remained uncorrected and was reconfirmed by the Assistant Director of Care. A resident was noted to be fed by an Activation Aide who also was seated above the resident's eye level, this was confirmed by the Assistant Director of Care.

The Revera on-line education provided to volunteers and recreation staff concerning Meal Time Assistance states, " Sit at eye level on the side to which the person pays the best attention". [s. 73. (1) 10.]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure residents receive personal assistance and encouragement required to safely eat and drink as comfortably as possible, to be implemented voluntarily.
