Bathing

s. 37 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that each resident of the home is bathed, at a minimum, twice a week by the method of their choice and more frequently as determined by the resident's hygiene requirements, unless contraindicated by a medical condition.

The licensee has failed to ensure that a resident was bathed, at a minimum, twice a week by the method of their choice.

Resident care records were reviewed for a specific three week period and had indicated that they had not received their scheduled twice-weekly baths. During an interview, a Personal Support Worker confirmed that all bathing activities, including resident refusals, were to be documented in the electronic health record. The Clinical Manager acknowledged and confirmed that the resident had not received the required two baths per week.
