The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

Non-compliance with requirements under the *Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007* (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

(9) The licensee shall ensure that the following are documented:

3. The effectiveness of the plan of care.

Findings:

- The effectiveness of a treatment was not documented in the interdisciplinary progress notes.

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WN # 2: The Licensee has failed to comply with the with O. Reg 79/10, s. 8

(1) Where the Act or this Regulation requires the licensee of a long-term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system,

- (a) is in compliance with and is implemented in accordance with all applicable requirements under the Act; and
- (b) is complied with.

Findings:

- As per section 82 (4) of the O. Reg 79/10 the licensee is required to enter into the appropriate written agreement under section 83 or 84 with every physician or registered nurse in the extended class retained or appointed under subsection (2) or (3).
- The Home has an Attending Physician Agreement between physicians and Rosebridge Manor.
- Section 3.7 of the Attending Physician Agreement specifies that the Attending Physician shall document on the resident's health record upon admission and upon subsequent visit to maintain continuity and ongoing evaluation of all medical services as these relate to clinical diagnosis.
- The transcripts of clinical observations made by the attending physician upon his visit are delivered to the home at a later date and eventually filed in the residents' progress notes as late entries.

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
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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the *Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007*, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152 (2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance with the requirement set out in the Attending Physician Agreement in relation to documentation on the health record upon each visit, to be implemented voluntarily.
