During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator, the Director of Care, the Assistant Director of Care, Registered Nursing Staff (RN/RPN), Personal Support Workers (PSW) and residents.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) conducted a waik through of resident care areas, observed staff to resident interactions, reviewed health care records and reviewed various policies and procedures.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 49. Falls prevention and management Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 49. (2) Every Ilcensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that when a resident has fallen, the resident is assessed and that where the condition or circumstances of the resident require, a post-fall assessment is conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for fails. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 49 (2).

#### Findings/Falts saillants:

- 1. Inspector reviewed the health care record for resident #009. Inspector noted the resident sustained a fall for which they were transferred to hospital. Inspector was unable to locate a completed post-fall assessment for this fall. It was reported to the inspector by the Director of Care that previously post-fall assessments were not being completed regularly and that the home continues to educate staff in this area. The licensee failed to ensure that when a resident has fallen, the resident is assessed and a post-fall assessment is conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for falls. [O.Reg. 79/10, s.49(2)]
- 2. Inspector reviewed the health care record for resident #008. Inspector noted the resident sustained a fall for which they were transferred to hospital. Inspector was unable to locate a completed post-fall assessment for this fall. Inspector spoke with the Assistant Director of Care who confirmed a post-fall assessment was not completed. The licensee failed to ensure that when a resident has fallen, the resident is assessed and a post-fall assessment is conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for falls. [O.Reg. 79/10, s.49(2)]

### Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance ensuring that when a resident has fallen, the resident is assessed and a post-fall assessment is conducted using a clinically appropriate assessment instrument that is specifically designed for falls., to be implemented voluntarily.
