Reports re critical incidents

s. 115 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the Director is immediately informed, in as much detail as is possible in the circumstances, of each of the following incidents in the home, followed by the report required under subsection (5):

5. An outbreak of a disease of public health significance or communicable disease as defined in the Health Protection and Promotion Act.

The licensee failed to immediately notify the Director of an outbreak of a disease of public health significance or communicable disease as defined in the Health Protection and Promotion Act.

Public health declared an outbreak in February 2024. The Director was not notified of the outbreak until two days later.

The IPAC manager acknowledged had they had not immediately reported the outbreak to the Director.

Failure to immediately report the outbreak to the Director may impede their ability to respond in a timely manner if required.
