The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Critical Incident inspection.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the administrator, staff nurse and a resident regarding H-000707-12.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) reviewed the home's investigation file for the alleged incident, an employee's personnel file and policies and procedures.

The inspector did not confirm that the licensee failed to protect residents from abuse by anyone.

The following Inspection Protocols were used during this inspection: Prevention of Abuse, Neglect and Retaliation

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 24. Reporting certain matters to Director

Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 24. (1) A person who has reasonable grounds to suspect that any of the following has occurred or may occur shall immediately report the suspicion and the information upon which it is based to the Director:
- 1. Improper or incompetent treatment or care of a resident that resulted in harm or a risk of harm to the resident.
- 2. Abuse of a resident by anyone or neglect of a resident by the licensee or staff that resulted in harm or a risk of harm to the resident.
- 3. Unlawful conduct that resulted in harm or a risk of harm to a resident.
- 4. Misuse or misappropriation of a resident's money.
- 5. Misuse or misappropriation of funding provided to a licensee under this Act or the Local Health System Integration Act, 2006. 2007, c. 8, ss. 24 (1), 195 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. On June 08, 2012, the inspector confirmed that an employee, who had reasonable grounds to suspect resident abuse had occurred in 2012, failed to immediately report the suspicion and the information upon which it was based to the Director named in the Long Term Care Homes Act. The employee reported the alleged resident abuse to the administrator in an e-mail. The administrator and the director of care, after being notified of the alleged abuse also failed to immediately report the suspicion to the Director. The Critical Incident Report was not received by the Director until five days after the incident occurred.

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance with ensuring staff who witness or suspect resident abuse to report it to the Director named in the Long Term Care Homes Act and O. Reg. 79/10 within the required time frames, to be implemented voluntarily.
