Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 40

Transferring and positioning techniques

s. 40. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that staff use safe transferring and positioning devices or techniques when assisting residents.

The licensee has failed to ensure that staff used safe transferring techniques when assisting a resident.

A resident sustained an injury during a transfer when assisted by a staff member. At the time of the incident, there was a discrepancy between the care plan and the transfer logo at the bedside.
