Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

# WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 72. Food production Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 72. (2) The food production system must, at a minimum, provide for,
- (a) a 24-hour supply of perishable and a three-day supply of non-perishable foods;
- (b) a three-day supply of nutritional supplements, enteral or parenteral formulas as applicable:
- (c) standardized recipes and production sheets for all menus;
- (d) preparation of all menu items according to the planned menu;
- (e) menu substitutions that are comparable to the planned menu;
- (f) communication to residents and staff of any menu substitutions; and
- (g) documentation on the production sheet of any menu substitutions. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 72 (2).

### Findings/Faits saillants:

1. During the inspection lunch meal service was observed on two separate days.

February 23rd, 2012 cheese sauce was not offered or available according to the menu for residents who selected the pureed ham, lettuce, tomato sandwich.

February 28th, 2012 residents on pureed diets were offered a pureed "monte cristo" sandwich (a grilled egg dipped sandwich of turkey and swiss cheese)according to the menu. Inspector taste tested the pureed menu item and confirmed with the Assistant Food Service Manager that the pureed menu item was not a "monte cristo" sandwich as planned. Residents on pureed diets were not offered all menu items according to the planned menu. The menu substitution was not comparable to the planned menu [r. 72. (2) (d)]

# WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 101. Dealing with complaints Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 101. (1) Every licensee shall ensure that every written or verbal complaint made to the licensee or a staff member concerning the care of a resident or operation of the home is dealt with as follows:
- 1. The complaint shall be investigated and resolved where possible, and a response that complies with paragraph 3 provided within 10 business days of the receipt of the complaint, and where the complaint alleges harm or risk of harm to one or more residents, the investigation shall be commenced immediately.
- 2. For those complaints that cannot be investigated and resolved within 10 business days, an acknowledgement of receipt of the complaint shall be provided within 10 business days of receipt of the complaint including the date by which the complainant can reasonably expect a resolution, and a follow-up response that complies with paragraph 3 shall be provided as soon as possible in the circumstances.
- 3. A response shall be made to the person who made the complaint, indicating,
- i. what the licensee has done to resolve the complaint, or
- ii. that the licensee believes the complaint to be unfounded and the reasons for the belief. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 101

1. Food related issues were raised at the August 2011 Resident Council meeting and documented on the home's "Resident Council Concern Form" dated August 26th, 2011. The food related issues were identified as follows: Some residents feel broccoli, carrots, asparagus are overcooked. Roast beef too tough and stringy and too dry; veal cutlet too much grease. Staff interview confirmed no response to residents was provided.[r. 101. (1) 1.]
