WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 65. Recreational and social activities program Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 65. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the program includes,
- (a) the provision of supplies and appropriate equipment for the program;
- (b) the development, implementation and communication to all residents and families of a schedule of recreation and social activities that are offered during days, evenings and weekends;
- (c) recreation and social activities that include a range of indoor and outdoor recreation, leisure and outings that are of a frequency and type to benefit all residents of the home and reflect their interests;
- (d) opportunities for resident and family input into the development and scheduling of recreation and social activities;
- (e) the provision of information to residents about community activities that may be of interest to them; and (f) assistance and support to permit residents to participate in activities that may be of interest to them if they are not able to do so independently. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 65 (2).

## Findings/Faits saillants:

- 1. The scheduled activity on one resident unit did not occur as planned.
- The canceled activity was not communicated to residents and staff.
- 2. During an interview, it was confirmed that the activity should have occurred at the scheduled time. [O.Reg.79/10 s.65(2)(b)]

## Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance with ensuring that there are adequate activities occurring on the unit and that these activities are communicated accurately and timely to residents, families and staff, to be implemented voluntarily.
