Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection



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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): July 16, 2015

This inspection was conducted as a result of a complaint IL 39125-LO regarding a resident leaving the building unsupervised.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with The Administrator, the Director of Nursing, the Behavioural Support Lead, two Registered Practical Nurses and four Personal Support Workers. The Inspector also observed a residents clinical record, the homes policies and procedures specifically regarding missing residents and observed general and specific resident care.

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Findings/Faits saillants:

1. The licensee failed to ensure that any plan, policy, protocol, strategy or system instituted or other wise put in place is complied with.

The Homes Policy for Missing Residents Policy EPM F-05

Code Yellow Missing Resident

last revised Feb 27, 2013, indicated that when a resident was found a nursing assessment would be completed and documented

The Care Plan would be updated

The Administrator or Director of Care would complete and submit a critical incident

A resident was observed on a street by an off duty staff member of the home.

The off duty staff member contacted a Registered Staff member and stated they would return the resident to the home.

The Registered staff member contacted the resident's Power of Attorney.

The off duty staff member returned the resident to the main floor of the building and left the resident there where he was seen by the a Registered Staff member in the common resident area.

Interview with six staff members revealed that none of them had been aware of this absence.

There was no documentation that the resident returned to the floor or was assessed by a staff member upon return to the floor.

The Director of Care confirmed that no code yellow was called, no nursing assessment was completed or documented when the resident returned, no follow up for the resident was completed or documented, the care plan was not updated and no critical incident was completed or submitted to the Director.

The Administrator confirmed the expectation was that the Code Yellow Policy was complied with. [s. 8. (1) (b)]



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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that where the Act or this Regulation requires the licensee of a long term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system is complied with, to be implemented voluntarily.
