The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Critical Incident inspection.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator and Director of Care regarding door security systems. (H-000430-12)

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) toured the home and tested stairwell door alarms and magnetic locks and measured the illumination level of lighting along the corridor on the first floor.

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Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 18. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the lighting requirements set out in the Table to this section are maintained. O. Findings/Faits saillants:

The licensee of the home has not ensured that the lighting requirements set out in the Table to this section are maintained. The corridors do not provide a minimum level of 215.28 lux of continuous consistent lighting throughout. Some of the light fixtures in the various corridors are spaced 8 to 12 feet apart, causing light and dark areas. The illumination levels on the first floor were measured with a light meter and levels between 490 and 40 lux were achieved. The level of 40 lux was measured between light fixtures in some locations.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 19. Generators Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 19. (4) The licensee of a home to which subsection (2) or (3) applies shall ensure, not later than six months after the day this section comes into force, that the home has guaranteed access to a generator that will be operational within three hours of a power outage and that can maintain everything required under clauses (1) (a), (b) and (c). O. Reg. 79/10, s. 19 (4).

Findings/Faits saillants:

[O. Reg. 79/10, s.19(4)] Victoria Gardens does not have guaranteed access to a generator that will be operational within three hours of a power outage and that can maintain essential services required under s. 19(1) of O. Reg. 79/10.

Victoria Gardens Long Term Care has Class B beds within the meaning of subsection 187(18) of the Act and therefore is not required to be served by a generator that is available at all times until December 31, 2016 as required by O. Reg. 79/10 s.19(2)2.

Further, if the home is able to retain the services of a generator rental company, the home currently does not have a generator panel and therefore no capacity to hook-up a generator to provide essential services including the residentstaff communication and response system, the elevator, dietary services equipment, the heating system, safety and emergency equipment including the fire alarm system and door security systems. Loss of these services in a prolonged power outage may pose a potential risk to the health, safety, comfort and well being of residents.



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Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that essential services are provided within three hours of a power outage, to be implemented voluntarily.
