Findings/Faits saillants:

1. The licensee has failed to comply with the home's policy and procedure on head injury routine (policy 11-01-04 reviewed in July 2011) for resident #001, resident #002, and resident #003.

A review of the home's head injury routine policy and procedure states the following: head injury routine is initiated on any resident who has experienced a blow to the head from any form of trauma sustained. Initiate head injury routine every 15 minutes for the first hour, every 30 minutes for the second hour, every one hour for four hours then every four hours for 72 hours. Hold all psychotropic medications and analgesics while on head injury routine.

Resident #001 had a fall on an identified date and was sent out to a hospital. He/she was then sent back to the long-term care home the same day and was started on head injury routine upon his/her return. However, record review and an interview with an identified Nurse Manager confirm that the head injury assessments for resident #001 were not completed as required by the home's head injury routine policy and procedure.

Resident #002 was started on head injury routine on an identified date due to a fall. However, record review and an interview with an identified interim Nurse Manager confirmed that the head injury assessments for resident #002 were not completed as required by the home's head injury routine policy and procedure.

Resident #003 was started on head injury routine on an identified date due to a fall. However, record review and an interview with an identified Nurse Manager confirmed that the head injury assessments for resident #003 were not completed as required by the home's head injury routine policy and procedure. Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that the home's head injury routine policy and procedure is complied with, to be implemented voluntarily.
