Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 20 (a)

Communication and response system

- s. 20. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home is equipped with a resident-staff communication and response system that,
- (a) can be easily seen, accessed and used by residents, staff and visitors at all times;

The licensee has failed to ensure that the home's resident-staff communication and response system can be easily seen, accessed and used by a specified resident at all times.

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 55 (2) (b) (ii)

Skin and wound care

- s. 55 (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,
- (b) a resident exhibiting altered skin integrity, including skin breakdown, pressure injuries, skin tears or wounds,
- (ii) receives immediate treatment and interventions to reduce or relieve pain, promote healing, and prevent infection, as required,



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The licensee has failed to ensure a specified resident exhibiting altered skin integrity of a pressure ulcer, received immediate treatment and interventions to reduce or relieve pain, promote healing, and prevent infection, as required.

(g) residents who require continence care products have sufficient changes to remain clean, dry and comfortable; and

The licensee has failed to ensure that a specified resident who required continence care products, had sufficient changes to remain clean, dry and comfortable on specified dates.
