WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

s. 6. (7) The licensee shall ensure that the care set out in the plan of care is provided to the resident as specified in the plan. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (7).

Findings/Faits sailiants:

1. The care set out in the plan of care was not provided to an identified resident as specified in the plan. The plan of care included monitoring at specific timed intervals of the resident for safety, related to risk. The plan did not specify that the checks should not be completed while the family was visiting the resident. The family stated the checks were not completed on while they were visiting on a specified date. The registered staff confirmed that the checks were not completed while family was visiting. The home's investigation confirmed that the checks had not been completed by staff while family was visiting on the identified date. s.6.(7)

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 101. Dealing with complaints Specifically failed to comply with the following subsections:

- s. 101. (1) Every licensee shall ensure that every written or verbal complaint made to the licensee or a staff member concerning the care of a resident or operation of the home is dealt with as follows:
- 1. The complaint shall be investigated and resolved where possible, and a response that complies with paragraph 3 provided within 10 business days of the receipt of the complaint, and where the complaint alleges harm or risk of harm to one or more residents, the investigation shall be commenced immediately.
- 2. For those complaints that cannot be investigated and resolved within 10 business days, an acknowledgement of receipt of the complaint shall be provided within 10 business days of receipt of the complaint including the date by which the complainant can reasonably expect a resolution, and a follow-up response that complies with paragraph 3 shall be provided as soon as possible in the circumstances.
- 3. A response shall be made to the person who made the complaint, indicating,
- i. what the licensee has done to resolve the complaint, or
- ii. that the licensee believes the complaint to be unfounded and the reasons for the belief. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 101 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:



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1. The licensee did not ensure that a response to a verbal complaint concerning the care of a resident was provided. The home received a verbal complaint of multiple care issues related to an identified resident in 2011. The home did not provide a response to the complainant up to date of this inspection. The Administrator confirmed that there is no record of response either in the resident's records or the home's complaint log. s.101.(1)1
