The purpose of this visit was to conduct an inspection related to a Critical Incident report submitted to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care.					
During the course of the inspection, the inspector spoke with the Administrator, Director of Care and the resident. During the course of the inspection, the resident's records (plan of care and progress notes), the home's investigative reports, staff in-service attendance records, educational materials and the home's policy on abuse were reviewed.

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

Non-respect avec les exigences sur le Loi de 2007 les foyers de soins de longue durée à trouvé. (Une exigence dans le loi comprend les exigences contenues dans les points énumérés dans la définition de "exigence prévue par la présente loi" au paragraphe 2(1) de la loi.

WN#1: The licensee has failed to comply with the LTCHA 2007, S.O., 2007, c.8, s.24(1)2. A person who has reasonable grounds to suspect that any of the following has occurred or may occur shall immediately report the suspicion and the information upon which it is based to the Director:

2. Abuse of a resident by anyone or neglect of a resident by the licensee or staff that resulted in harm or a risk of harm to the resident.

Findings:

An identified resident was verbally abused by a staff member that was witnessed by another person. The incident was reported to the Administrator via a written letter 2 days later, however the incident was not immediately reported to the Director and was only submitted 14 days later.

WN#2: The licensee has failed to comply with O. Reg. 79/10, s. 96(a)(c) and (e). Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the licensee's written policy under section 20 of the Act to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents,

- (a) contains procedures and interventions to assist and support residents who have been abused or neglected or allegedly abused or neglected;
- (c) identifies measures and strategies to prevent abuse and neglect;
- (e) identifies the training and retraining requirements for all staff, including,
 - training on the relationship between power imbalances between staff and residents and the
 potential for abuse and neglect by those in a position of trust, power and responsibility for
 resident care, and
 - ii) situations that may lead to abuse and neglect and how to avoid such situations.

Findings:

The home's policy titled "Abuse Policy ADM-VI-06", last updated January 2008 does not contains procedures and interventions to assist and support residents who have been abused or neglected or allegedly abused or neglected, does not identify measures and strategies to prevent abuse and neglect, does not identify the training and retraining requirements for all staff, including,

i) training on the relationship between power imbalances between staff and residents and the potential for abuse and neglect by those in a position of trust, power and responsibility for



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ii) situations that may lead to abuse and neglect and how to avoid such situations.

WN#3: The licensee has failed to comply with the LTCHA, 2007, S.O 2007, c.8, s.19. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall protect residents from abuse by anyone and shall ensure that residents are not neglected by the licensee or staff.

Findings:

The identified resident was verbally abused by a staff member who used profanity and made an additional statement that was degrading and humiliating to the resident. The verbal abuse was witnessed by another person. Resident records and staff documentation were reviewed and interviews conducted that confirm that the incident occurred.
