WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with LTCHA, 2007 S.O. 2007, c.8, s. 6. Plan of care

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 6. (7) The licensee shall ensure that the care set out in the plan of care is provided to the resident as specified in the plan. 2007, c. 8, s. 6 (7).

Findings/Faits saillants :



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1. The licensee did not ensure that the care set out in residents' plan of care was provided as specified in the plan.

At lunch on November 28th, 2012 three residents with individualized nutritional care needs were observed.

Resident A, modified diabetic, has a plan of care requiring only fruit and not dessert to be offered at meals. Resident A was offered a choice between the dessert (tiramisu mousse) and fruit when staff visually showed and offered both choices.

Resident B has a plan of care requiring foods to be served according to an individualized therapeutic menu. Resident B was served foods contrary to the individualized menu. Foods served included an ingredient to be avoided.

Resident C has a plan of care requiring a feeding device at meals. Resident C was not provided this feeding device at the lunch meal observed.

Staff serving meals were observed not referring to the diet information list and individualized menus available. Staff were observed requesting meals by diet texture "2 minced and 1 pureed" and not by resident name. [s. 6. (7)]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure nutritional care is provided as specified in Residents' A, B and C's plan of care, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 71. Menu planning

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 71. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the home's menu cycle,

(e) is approved by a registered dietitian who is a member of the staff of the home; O. Reg. 79/10, s. 71 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants :



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1. The Food Service Manager and current Registered Dietitian confirmed through interview that the home's 2012 menu cycle implemented February 2012 was not approved by the previous Registered Dietitian who was a member of the staff of the home. The home's current Registered Dietitian also confirmed that she has not completed the approval process for the 2012 menu cycle. [s. 71. (1) (e)]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure the home's menu cycle is approved by a registered dietitian who is a member of the staff of the home, to be implemented voluntarily.
