- 2. The plan of care for May 2011 states the resident is able to undo restraint on wheelchair and climb out of the wheelchair and requires to be checked on an hourly basis.
- 3. Strategies continue to be ineffective as the resident continues to have falls as a result of undoing the chair restraint.
- 4. The plan of care was updated on May 2011, however there are no changes or alternative approaches considered despite the resident continuing to have multiple falls.

When service is made by registered mail, it is deemed to be made on the fifth day after the day of mailing and when service is made by fax, it is deemed to be made on the first business day after the day the fax is sent. If the Licensee is not served with written notice of the Director's decision within 28 days of receipt of the Licensee's request for review, this(these) Order(s) is(are) deemed to be confirmed by the Director and the Licensee is deemed to have been served with a copy of that decision on the expiry of the 28 day period.

The Licensee has the right to appeal the Director's decision on a request for review of an Inspector's Order(s) to the Health Services Appeal and Review Board (HSARB) in accordance with section 164 of the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007. The HSARB is an independent tribunal not connected with the Ministry. They are established by legislation to review matters concerning health care services. If the Licensee decides to request a hearing, the Licensee must, within 28 days of being served with the notice of the Director's decision, give a written notice of appeal to both:
