Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection

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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Follow up inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): August 12 and 13, 2021.

The purpose of the this inspection was to conduct a follow-up Inspection to a Order related to Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) issued in Inspection 2021_838760_0008. A review of the home's Cooling and Air Temperature Requirements was also completed.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with Executive Director, Facility Manager, Director of Care, Personal Support Workers and Registered Practical Nurses.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector toured resident home areas, conducted observations of staff hand hygiene; donning doffing of personal care equipment, meal service. A review of IPAC audits, training records and policies were completed.

Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (a requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA).

**WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 21. Air temperature
Specifically failed to comply with the following:**

s. 21. (3) The temperature required to be measured under subsection (2) shall be documented at least once every morning, once every afternoon between 12 p.m. and 5 p.m. and once every evening or night. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 21 (3).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that the air temperature was measured and documented in writing, at a minimum in two resident bedrooms and common area of every floor of the home at least once every morning, once every afternoon between 12 p.m. and 5 p.m. and once every evening or night .

On August 12, 2021, the Inspector requested from the Facility Manager (FM) to provide the home's air temperature records. The FM was unable to produce documentation and confirmed that they had not been measuring and documenting air temperatures in at least two resident bedrooms once every evening or night and one common area on every floor for the home at least once every morning, once every afternoon between 12 p.m. and 5 p.m. and once every evening or night.

An interview with the ED confirmed the required air temperature monitoring was lacking in at least two resident rooms once every evening or night and common areas, on every floor, three times a day and modified the audit form accordingly.
