## WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Skin and wound care

NC #001 Written Notification pursuant to FLTCA, 2021, s. 154 (1) 1.



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#### Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 55 (2) (a) (ii)

Skin and wound care

- s. 55 (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,
- (a) a resident at risk of altered skin integrity receives a skin assessment by an authorized person described in subsection (2.1)
- (ii) upon any return of the resident from hospital, and

The licensee failed to ensure that when a resident received a skin assessment when they returned from hospital.

A complaint was received by the Ministry of Long Term Care (MLTC) related to the management of an alteration in skin integrity, of a resident.

The homes policy on skin care and wound management directed the registered staff to complete a head to toe assessment anytime a resident returned from hospital.

A head to toe assessment was not completed for the resident when they returned from hospital.

## WRITTEN NOTIFICATION: Skin and wound care

Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 55 (2) (b) (iv)

Skin and wound care

s. 55 (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,

(b) a resident exhibiting altered skin integrity, including skin breakdown, pressure



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injuries, skin tears or wounds,

(iv) is reassessed at least weekly by an authorized person described in subsection (2.1), if clinically indicated;

The licensee failed to ensure that a resident was reassessed weekly when they exhibited an alteration in skin integrity.

A complaint was received by the Ministry of Long Term Care (MLTC) related to the management of alteration in skin integrity on a resident.

In a skin assessment indicated the resident had an alteration in their skin integrity. The homes policy on skin and wound management program directed the staff to complete a Skin and Wound Assessment in the resident's electronic health record on a weekly basis.

The required weekly skin assessments were not completed on multiple weeks.
