WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 107. Reports re critical incidents



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

- s. 107. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the Director is immediately informed, in as much detail as is possible in the circumstances, of each of the following incidents in the home, followed by the report required under subsection (4):
- 1. An emergency, including fire, unplanned evacuation or intake of evacuees. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 107 (1).
- 2. An unexpected or sudden death, including a death resulting from an accident or suicide. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 107 (1).
- 3. A resident who is missing for three hours or more. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 107 (1).
- 4. Any missing resident who returns to the home with an injury or any adverse change in condition regardless of the length of time the resident was missing. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 107 (1).
- 5. An outbreak of a reportable disease or communicable disease as defined in the Health Protection and Promotion Act. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 107 (1).
- 6. Contamination of the drinking water supply. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 107 (1).
- s. 107. (4) A licensee who is required to inform the Director of an incident under subsection (1), (3) or (3.1) shall, within 10 days of becoming aware of the incident, or sooner if required by the Director, make a report in writing to the Director setting out the following with respect to the incident:
- 5. The name and title of the person who made the initial report to the Director under subsection (1) or (3), the date of the report and whether an inspector has been contacted and, if so, the date of the contact and the name of the inspector. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 107 (4).

Findings/Faits saillants:



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- 1. 1. The licensee failed to inform the Director immediately, in as much detail as is possible in the circumstances, of an outbreak of a reportable disease or communicable disease as defined in the Health Protection and Promotion Act. Critical Incident #2934-000004-14 revealed that the licensee failed to report to the Director immediately the onset of the respiratory outbreak on March 7, 2014. Critical Incident #2934-000006-14 revealed that the licensee failed to report to the Director immediately the onset of a respiratory outbreak on April 9, 2014. The DOC confirmed that the Director was informed 7 days after the onset of the first outbreak, on March 7, 2014, and 8 days after the onset of the outbreak, on April 9, 2014. [s. 107. (1)]
- 2. The licensee failed to ensure the written reported includes whether an inspector has been contacted, and, if so, the date of the contact and the name of the inspector. Record review and staff interview confirmed that the above mentioned reports do not include, whether an inspector had been contacted, and if so, the date of the contact and name of the inspector. [s. 107. (4) 5.]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance by ensuring that every outbreak is reported immediately to the Director, to be implemented voluntarily.
